# Bee reporter wins award for public-records access

BERKELEY - The California First Amendment Coalition presented Bee staff writer Denny Walsh with an award Saturday for overcoming obstacles to access public records.

"He gets the information to the public, the readers and public officials that they need to make decisions," the coalition's treasurer, Mel Opotowsky, said in an interview.

The Beacon Award recognizes not only Walsh's recent battles for federal court

documents, but also his lifetime achievement.

"There's always somebody trying to hide something," Walsh said. "I've spent most of my adult life trying to subvert that effort."

He has reported for publications around the country and won many awards during his 45-year career as a newsman.

Walsh and another reporter shared a Pulitzer Prize for investigative reporting in 1969 while at the St. Louis Globe-Democrat.

Walsh moved from St. Louis to Life magazine and then the New York Times before coming to The McClatchy Co., which owns The Bee, in 1974. He then joined The Bee's staff in 1987.

McClatchy Chairman Gary Pruitt emphasized the importance of the award, noting that it honors journalism's fight to protect the First Amendment.

"It is critical that we have reporters like Denny who tell the truth and don't back down," Pruitt said.
